ACCESSING JOURNALS

Talk to your librarian to find out what journals are available to you. Below are some key titles, which may be available online via your library website:

- » Assessment and Evaluation in Higher Education (Routledge)
- » New Directions for Teaching and Learning (Wiley)
- » Teaching in Higher Education (Routledge)

Directory of Open Access Journals (www.doaj.org) provides free open access to a large number of scholarly journals including:

- » International Journal for the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (IJSOTL)
- » International Journal of Teaching and Learning in Higher Education (ITJLHE)
- » Journal of Online Learning and Teaching (JOLT)
- » Journal of Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (JoSoTL)
- » Journal of University Teaching and Learning Practice (JUTLP)
- » Learning and Teaching in Higher Education (LATHE)

TIP: Don't confine yourself. General Higher Education journals and discipline specific journals will also include articles relevant to teaching practice.

SEARCH FOR ARTICLES

A database search will pull together all journals by a particular publisher e.g. Informaworld (Taylor & Frances) (www.informaworld.com) or journals from a variety of publishers in a specific field e.g. Academic Search Premier for Higher Education journals.

TIP: Check with your subject librarian to find out what databases your Library holds.

TIP: Discipline-specific databases should also be searched for articles on aspects of teaching and learning in different subject areas e.g. Inspec for engineers and physicists.

KEEPING UP TO DATE

Most major databases (available via your library) allow you to easily save your search and get an email alert when new articles match your search criteria. You can also get table of contents for your favourite journals delivered to your inbox. If you need help contact your Subject Librarian.
